#### FEEDING DIRECTIONS

1. For calves not adapted to eating grain, begin feeding T & S Steer Feed at the rate of 1% of bodyweight split into two equal feedings.

2. Grain may be increased at the rate of 1 lb/day up to 2% of bodyweight/day. Then slowly increase grain intake at the rate of 1/2 lb/day as the calf increases its appetite. Do not exceed 29 lbs grain/hd/day.

3. For best results, feed a small amount (5 lbs/day) of good guality hay in addition to T & S Steer Feed. Always provide plenty of clean, fresh water.

CAUTION: Feed is perishable. Store in a dry, well-ventilated area. NEVER feed moldy or insect-infested feed.
