SHOW TERMS

Beef:

• Fitting – grooming for show

• Blocking chute – metal stantion used as the "barber's chair". Cattle can walk in and rest with their heads tied in show position while being groomed.

• Blower - high speed hair dryer

• Clippers – to cut hair, of course! Large clippers are for preliminary work and the small clippers are for the finishing touches.

- Adhesive the maximum strength hair spray used on cattle. This glue comes in several strengths for different areas of the body.
- Show stick used to position and calm the animal.

Terms Used with Show Swine:

- Gilt a female that has not yet had a litter of piglets
- Sow a female that has had a litter of piglets
- Shoat a teenage pig.
- Barrow a castrated male
- Boar a fully intact male, able to breed
- Piglet young swine not yet weaned
- Pig any swine 125lbs and under
- Hog any swine over 125lbs
- Drive you will hear the phrase "on the drive", this means walking or on the move Terms Used with Show Swine:
